LEGAL NOTICE OF ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that the Jefferson County Commission has called and ordered a special election to be held in the Trussville School District on April 12, 2022, at which there will be submitted to the qualified electors of said district, for their determination by ballot, the question of whether a special district tax of \$1.39 on each one hundred dollars (equal to 13.9 mills on each dollar) of the assessed value of taxable property located within the said school district shall be levied for public school purposes for a period of twenty-five (25) consecutive years commencing with the tax year that began on October 1, 2021 (for which first tax year the tax will become due and payable on October 1, 2022), and continuing to and including the tax year beginning on October 1, 2045 (for which tax year the tax will become due and payable on October 1, 2046), which levy shall not increase the total rate of taxation in the said District, but shall be in continuation of the 5.1 mill school district tax presently authorized for the said period and now being levied in the Trussville School District and shall replace and be in lieu of the 8.8 mill school district tax last levied for collection commencing October 1, 2021 in the Trussville School District.

The said election will be held at First Baptist Church-Trussville, Trussville Civic Center, Trussville City Hall, Faith Community Fellowship and North Park Baptist Church, all in the Trussville School District, during the hours of 7:00am to 7:00pm.
