Dear Nominees, Jefferson County Personnel Board, Classified Employees of Jefferson County, Municipalities of Jefferson County and other interested parties:


On Tuesday, September 19, 2023 nominations were accepted to fill the seats of the Citizens Supervisory Commission's Municipal and County Employee Representative. Only one nominee was received for each position.

Jasmine Matthews of the Probate Department was nominated for the County Employee Representative position, and Ashley Oliver of the Trussville Revenue Department was nominated for the Municipal Employee Representative position.

As a result of only one nominee per position, an election will not be held on October 19, 2023; therefore, Jasmine Matthews will serve as the Citizens Supervisory Commission County Employee Representative and Ashley Oliver will serve as the Citizens Supervisory Commission Municipal Employee Representative. The terms will begin November 1, 2023 and end October 31, 2024.
